NO BRITISH WITHDRAWAL?

For more than thirty-five years the British government have pursued a policy of 'normalisation' in Ireland, seeking to portray the occupation of the six counties as 'normal' and 'democratic' - while in reality it is neither.

It isn't 'normal' for a country to be partitioned into two states and it isn't democratic for one-fifth of the population to have a 'unionist veto' over the wishes of the other four-fifths.

There are 5,000 British combat troops permanently based in Ireland. Their Commander in Chief, who is also the head of the British state, is one Elizabeth Windsor aka the British Queen.
